Den Meetings

Dens are groups of boys in the same grade who meet together with adult leaders, and work on requirements to achieve a Cub Scout rank award. The following are the den ranks in Cub Scouts:



Den Meetings are typically held on Friday evenings, once or twice a month, from Sept. or Oct., through May or June. They typically start between 6:15pm and 7:30pm depending on the den, and last for 1 - 1.5 hours.

Pack Meetings

Typically held once a month on a Friday, from 7:00pm to approx. 8:30pm. These are meetings of all our Scouts (all Dens) at which we recognize scouts for their achievements and enjoy a variety of fun activities and snacks. Some of our Pack meetings include a Halloween Party, Carnival Games, and Holiday Party.

Why Cub Scouts?

In Cub Scouts your child will have lots of fun, learn new things, and make new friends. At Pack 19, we engage scouts in skill building, crafts, games, and sports. We go on trips, work on community service projects and let scouts try new activities such as camping and hiking. **But Cub Scouts is much more than that, it's fun with a purpose.** Scouts engage in activities and earn awards that allow them to enhance basic character traits of citizenship, cooperation, leadership, respect, responsibility, health and fitness and faith. We also engage the entire family in many of our activities. You can bring siblings to meetings, and if resources are available, they sometimes can participate in the same activities the scouts are working on. **It's NEVER too late to join!**

Activities

We have a lot of fun in Pack 19! In addition to Den and Pack meetings, we also have a lot of other activities, including:

- Camping and Overnights
 - Cub Scout Overnight Summer Camp (July or August, usually 3 nights, adults can attend)
 - Generally, one or two overnight camping trips during the year including one at a museum or attraction such as the Battleship New Jersey and Franklin Institute
 - Council Jamborees and the annual Klondike Derby for older scouts
 - Summer sleepover at the Trenton Thunder stadium
- Trips to entertainment and sports activities (fees apply, tickets are generally at a discount)
 - Harlem Globetrotters, monster trucks, baseball/basketball/hockey games
- Hiking and other outdoor activities
- Pinewood Derby in March, where scouts build and race a small wooden car
- Bowling and other similar activities
- Community Outreach
 - Caroling at Attleboro Senior Residence in December
 - Replacing flags at local cemeteries
 - Participation in the Langhorne Memorial Day Parade



Annual Registration Fees

Our Annual Registration Fee for new scouts is \$230 for the period from November 2021 thru December 2022 (14 months). Also, if you wish to receive a subscription to Scouting Life magazine, you can do so for \$1 more a month (\$244 total).

A Scout's Pack Registration Fee pays for the following:

- National Boy Scouts of America fees and insurance coverage
- All award patches, pins, and belt loops earned during the year
- Den meeting supplies
- All newly registering scouts receive a Pack 19 hat and neckerchief slide



Parent/Adult Partner Expectations – Scouting Runs on Volunteers!

All Scouting organizations including ours ask that parents/adult partners provide help with activities by volunteering your time, to the extent you can do so. We can always use more hands. In addition to passing background checks, volunteers must also complete the BSA's online Youth Protection Training course every two years.
